Application Submission

Self-nominations and institutional nominations are accepted free of charge.

02

Document Verification

Credentials, teaching experience, service record and supporting evidence are reviewed.

03

Evaluation Committee Review

Applications are evaluated on Teaching Effectiveness, Innovation, Impact & Leadership.

04

Shortlisting

A category-wise shortlist is prepared and communicated to shortlisted nominees.

Every application is reviewed on merit — free of charge, at every stage.

Selection Process — Stages 5–7

A Transparent Seven-Stage Review

05

Final Evaluation

Shortlisted educators undergo in-depth assessment of achievements & contribution.

06

Selection Committee Decision

The final selection is made by the designated selection committee.

07

Award Ceremony

Selected educators are honoured at the annual ceremony, proposed in Malaysia, Oct 2026.
